Aitchison Earthquakers have always had a great following and the recent rains around New Zealand have shown that many paddocks have panning problems.

Grass growth can be increased by up to 20 per cent in paddocks that have been cured from panning according to scientific studies.

"Considering an Aitchison Earthquaker can be bought for as little as \$5310 plus GST, it could well be the best investment you'll ever make on the farm."

The Aitchison Earthquakers have been produced by the company for many years alongside heavy duty rippers.

The Earthquaker uses high tensile steel to create a refined piece of machinery with maximum underground but minimum aboveground disturbance.

Slender high tensile bisalloy legs and wings create a "wave" movement in the paddock effectively breaking up the pan whilst your pasture stays in tact. The machines come standard with coulter discs and an optional steel roller.

The Aitchison Wideline Cultivator series has a heavy frame and tines, road legal transport width and superior angled crumbler rollers make for a well finished quality machine.

Prices start at \$39,000 for the 6.85m wide model.
